2. Size of the cards should be 4 1/4 x 5 1/2 inches. (This is an A4 size card) No need to supply envelopes unless you want to.
3. Bazzill cardstock is best; you can use heavy cardstock also if you wish.
4. Please embellish each card front at least twice. DO NOT use stickers as embellishments. Patterned paper does not count as an embellishment. Also all supplies need to be acid free.
5. Please DO NOT use your own handwriting on the cards. Computer, stamps, etc. are all OK for the words.
6. There is no need to fill the inside of the card unless you want to. Blanks are OK.
7. Please bring your completed cards to SSS in a ziploc bag with your name written on it.
8. Envelopes do not need to be included.

Sign up for the club number three which will start in February and run through June.
